

## Toronto Grace - Eligibility Criteria

Of note, we recently trialed discharged from ED to home to prevent hospital admission and it is working well. With that, I foresee that RCM for covid clients in the community will work well. We can integrate the pathway to a CACs or our own outpatient clinic (that we have already incorporated in our RCM pathways).

We are currently covering the following regions: OH-Toronto, Central East, Central, and Central West.  
RCM Eligibility Criteria

- \* Medically stable
- \* OHIP coverage/landed immigrant status (please note that TGHC will also cover those without OHIP
- \* Transitioning from hospital (ALC and/or at high risk of readmission) or in the community and at risk of hospital admission or LTC
- \* Referral by a health care professional (Primary Care Provider, Specialist, nurse, or allied health professionals as per the Regulated Health Professionals' Act)
- \* Requires support to help with safety and independence in the home (e.g., an assessed fall risk), or in a community setting
- \* Requires vital sign monitoring both continuous or intermittent
- \* Have an escalation point while in the community (e.g., currently enrolled with and/or have applied for Home and Community care Support Services)

Exclusion Criteria:

- No escalation point
- No fixed address
- Medically unstable
