

OLIS-MORE — ID Now™ Sites

What is OLIS-MORE?

Mobile Orders and Result Entry (OLIS-MORE) is a web-based application that enables direct submission of electronic COVID 19 Test Requisition Orders and Results to the Ontario Laboratories Information System (OLIS).

OLIS-MORE has two main components:

- OLIS-MORE Test Requisition Orders and Results Submission to a COVID-19 testing lab (e-order)
- OLIS-MORE Results Reporting for Direct Submission of Results (Point of Care Rapid Testing)

Benefits of OLIS-MORE:

- An online web form, providing mobility, access, and ease of use
- Real-time data validation
- Performing lab can pull the e-order into their Lab Information System (LIS), eliminating manual entry
- Ability to print barcoded labels for specimens
- Generation of an MRN for results lookup in the provincial COVID-19 results viewer
- Ability to save requisition and retrieve later (within 24 hours)
- Pre-validation/review and editing prior to submission of requisitions
- Labs can receive requisition orders directly from OLIS via e-Order
- Submission of results for ID Now Rapid testing sites not associated with a lab
- Successful submission to OLIS validated

Why do I need to be on-boarded to OLIS-MORE?

The provincial lab system strategy is “all digital.” We expect that all COVID-19 testing sites will submit Test Requisition Orders in a digital format to provincial labs by 2022. ID Now Rapid Testing sites not associated with a lab will also submit their results directly to OLIS via OLIS-MORE. The goal is to eliminate all paper-based requisitions and manual entry performed by labs, and to ensure the completeness of data.

Why is this critical?

OLIS-MORE ensures that the data is as comprehensive and timely as possible. This data is critical to ensuring that clinicians, public health units and patients receive timely results, as well as supporting patient management and contact tracing.

What is the Ministry directive on COVID-19 Testing?

Guidance document: Ministry Directive for COVID 19 Testing

All molecular test results, including molecular POC tests (such as ID NOW Rapid Testing), should be uploaded with a minimum of the data elements required for laboratory results, and uploaded into OLIS; or where OLIS is not available, through an alternate secure method, as per Ontario Health guidelines and in accordance with the Health Protection and Promotion Act.

All COVID-19 results for rapid testing sites must be submitted into OLIS.

What is the obligation of sites utilizing ID NOW™ testing?

All sites using ID NOW are obligated to submit results into OLIS. If your Specimen Collection site does not have a lab submitting results on your behalf, your site is obligated to participate in OLIS-MORE to ensure that results are submitted into OLIS.

I'm already providing an aggregated report to Ontario Health?

The aggregated report of your Rapid results that you are currently providing to Ontario Health was intended as an interim work-around until OLIS-MORE was available. Results submission directly into OLIS (such as using OLIS-MORE) is the required method of reporting going forward.
