The CQCO Quality and Innovation (QI) Awards 2023 welcome applications from any institution, practice or organization that provides cancer prevention activities or cares for people being treated for or living with cancer in Ontario.

The *Innovation Award* is presented to a program or initiative that best demonstrates these criteria:

- Originality and boldness
- Improved outcomes
- Sustainability
- Economic benefits
- Meaningful impact on patients, families, resources and processes

The QI Awards define innovation as new and unique processes, products or organizations that are bold, experimental, and far-reaching. The goal of innovation should be to improve the process, organization or product.

The nomination must show a plan for evaluation or measurable evidence for how the innovative initiative improved outcomes.

Upon preliminary review of your nomination, we may recommend that your submission be considered for a different award category.
